



# Be an online student of teaching

- Enrol in an online course in how to teach.
- Have deadlines, and assessment, to make the experience real.

### Build the course around the assessment:

1. Set the learning objectives,

2. Select assessment to cover them,

3. Provide support to obtain the knowledge and skills needed for the assessment,
4. Have many small regular assessment items and a few big ones

### Make time for contact with students

- Drop most lectures
- Get students to communicate more
- Answer student questions to the group
- Use tools to free up your time
- Don't use email to communicate with students

- 2. Generate slideshows
- 3. Provide video to supplement the text
- 4. Implement accessibility guidelines
